 [20] For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. (Romans 1:20 ESV)

We are called to be like Him through KNOWLEDGE of His EXCELLENCE

[29] Do you see a man skillful in his work? He will stand before kings; he will not stand before obscure men. (Proverbs 22:29 ESV)

Divine FAVOR: The Makings Of A Generational Change-Agent

The LORD was with Joseph, and he became a successful man, and he was in the house of his Egyptian master. His master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD caused all that he did to succeed in his hands. So Joseph found favor in his sight and attended him, and he made him overseer of his house and put him in charge of all that he had. (Genesis 39:2–4)

Activating divine favor through PURITY and hunger for HOLINESS
 [9] No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God's seed abides in him, and he cannot keep on sinning because he has been born of God.
 (1 John 3:9 ESV)

Reflecting Jesus – Our Attitude to Work is a Reflection of our Faith

- [23] Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, [24] knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. (Colossians 3:23-24 ESV)
- Excellence: Surpassing Ordinary Standards
 - Excellence in the small things the opposite of mediocrity
 - [3] Then this Daniel became distinguished above all the other high officials and satraps, because an <u>excellent spirit was in him</u>. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom. (Daniel 6:3 ESV)
 - The Protestant Work Ethic Hard Work + Discipline+ Frugality + Excellence = Success.

1) Godly Perseverance & Tolerance for Enduring Adversity

- I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. I can do all things through him who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:11–13)
- 23 The steps of a man are established by the LORD, when he delights in his way;
 24 though he fall, he shall not be cast headlong, for the LORD upholds his hand.

2) Don't Just Dream - Be the Answer

Insights without solutions is not enough (Gen. 41)

[33] Now therefore let Pharaoh select a discerning and wise man, and set him over the land of Egypt. [34] Let Pharaoh proceed to appoint overseers over the land and take one-fifth of the produce of the land of Egypt during the seven plentiful years. [35] And let them gather all the food of these good years that are coming and store up grain under the authority of Pharaoh for food in the cities, and let them keep it. [36] That food shall be a reserve for the land against the seven years of famine that are to occur in the land of Egypt, so that the land may not perish through the famine." (Genesis 41:33-36 ESV)

 - [9] you whom I took from the ends of the earth, and called from its farthest corners, saying to you, <u>"You are my servant, I have chosen you and not cast you off"; [10] fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:9-10 ESV)</u>

1) Integrity & Humility (Issues of the HEART)
